In compliance to the supply code 2021 to ensure smooth transition from existing practice, this new practice of Personal Hearing at request of consumer in enforcement booked cases under section 126 IEA TPADL to be started w.e.f. 06 Sep., 2021.

3. Higher authority for approval- Group Head/ Head Enforcement TPADL Ajmer.
4. Appeal before Appellate Authority under Section 127 of the Act - SE / CE (T&C) RVPNL Ajmer.

(b) List of assessing/authorize officers under section 135 of the ACT

1. Authorize officers- Zonal Managers /Sub Divisional Manager /Enforcement Lead Engineer TPADL Ajmer.
2. Assessing officer- Enforcement assessment cell TPADL Ajmer.
3. Appeal before Appellate Authority under Section 135 of the Act - SE / CE /MD (O&M) AVVNL Ajmer.


(c) Officers authorized by commission to disconnect supply of section 135 of the ACT

1. LT Supply - Zonal Managers /Sub Divisional Manager /Enforcement Lead Engineer TPADL Ajmer.
2. HT Supply - Group Head/ Head Enforcement TPADL Ajmer.

Conditions applicable:-

1. The Assessing officer shall arrange a personal hearing with the consumer or his authorized representative within 7 (seven) days from the date of filing of consumer's objections.
2. At the request of the consumer, the hearing may be arranged for a future date but not later than 10 (ten) days from the date of filing of the objections by the consumer.

3. The Assessing officer shall pass a final assessment order within 30 (thirty) days from the date of service of the order of provisional assessment of the electricity charges payable by such person.
4. The final order of assessment shall clearly show as to whether the case of unauthorized use of electricity is established or not. Such Order shall contain the brief of inspection report, submissions, oral or written, made by consumer and reasons for acceptance or rejections of the same.
5. If no unauthorized use of electricity is established, the Assessing officer shall pass an Assessment Order dropping the case immediately and the consumer shall be informed accordingly with a copy to the next higher officer.
6. The assessment of energy in the final order shall be made as per Appendix-I to the Regulations: Provided that if unauthorized use of electricity is on account of wrong usage of tariff category or for the premises or areas other than for which supply of electricity was authorized, the Assessing officer shall take assessment of energy as recorded in the meter for the period of assessment.
7. The Final Assessment Order, shall clearly mention that the Order is appealable by the consumer before the Appellate Authority (name, designation and address to be mentioned) within 30 (thirty) days of serving the said order as per provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 127 of the Act.
